

Dear Parents/Carers

Our Christmas appeal will again be to support the New Hope Food Bank. This is a community based food bank serving Killamarsh and the surrounding areas within a 6 mile radius. It covers all of our school catchment area and provides emergency food for up to seven days to individuals and families who are in short term crisis. Those who receive the donations must have been referred to the food bank by professional organisations such as social care/a multi-agency team or the Citizens Advice Bureau.

The New Hope Food bank also works to help people who find themselves in financial crisis by directing them to relevant agencies such as money management and cognitive therapy. The immediate practical help provided by New Hope Food Bank gives their clients and the referral agency breathing space to work together to help resolve the underlying problems.
