## UCAS and Careers Event Monday 4<sup>th</sup> July to Friday 8<sup>th</sup> July 2016

Eckington School's UCAS and Careers Week is designed to be an intensive introduction to routes ahead for Y12 students when they leave post-16 studies and, as such, it is an essential part of their planning for the future. It is, therefore, compulsory for all students to take part.

The week consists of a variety of activities and visits:

- Monday Careers /UCAS Fair**  
Presentations, drop-in sessions and stands from providers such as Sheffield, Sheffield Hallam, Nottingham and Derby Universities; Chamber of Commerce, CITB construction advice and careers; Age Concern; Army and Police careers; Barclays Bank Life Skills; Connexions. Other organisations will also be present to offer advice on courses and careers.
- Tuesday Visit to Derby University**  
The morning will be taken up by a tour of the university campus and talks from university representatives.
- Wednesday Training / Apprenticeship / UCAS Research and Application**  
Advice and assistance will be given on the individual's chosen route by teaching staff and by a selection of outside providers. By the end of this day students will have researched and made a start on applying for their chosen course.
- Thursday Visit to Scarborough**  
A reward for the hard work completed so far. Highlights will include a staff v student pitch and putt competition and a search for the fossilised giant whelk of Scarborough Castle!
- Friday Personal Statements and Barbecue**  
The morning will be spent researching and writing personal statements for UCAS, training and apprenticeship applications. Non-UCAS students will have the opportunity to undertake a practice interview with local employers/providers. Expert assistance will be on hand from university admissions tutors and current undergraduates from a variety of disciplines. In the afternoon, we will have a barbecue to celebrate the end of a busy, fruitful week.
